MUSEUM COUNCIL FELLOWS

Members contribute \$1,000 to \$10,000 annually. Each contribution enables two people to participate and receive the following benefits:

In addition to receiving all benefits of general Museum membership, Museum Council members enjoy preferential viewing privileges for major exhibitions and are invited to exclusive special events designed to bring them closer to the Museum, its collections, and staff.
